Day 01 Arrive in Chengdu

Zhuge Kongming is an avatar in China.

Activities: After breakfast you will set off for The front gate of Mt. Qingcheng. It is Located about 15 kilometers from the southeast of Dujiangyan City, Sichuan Province, Mt. Qingcheng lies amidst the Western Mountains covered with pure white snow, and dominates the fertile land of Chengdu. You can take the cable car for deep feeling of the Mt.Qingcheng.In the afternoon the guide will lead you to Dujiangyan Irrigation Project and Yuecheng Lake. Dujiangyan is an Irrigation System, which was built over 2250 years ago to irrigate the Chengdu Basin, and it effectively controls flooding and has been cultivated the whole basin for more than 2000 years already.
